The GPAC Safety Awards Program is an important part of an industry wide recognition for safe work at gas handling facilities across Canada. Some plants/facilities have been participating in the program since its inception over 30 years ago.

Many companies throughout the gas processing industry choose to recognize the exceptional safety records of their staff alongside industry peers through the GPAC Awards.

To register your plant or facility, we require the following for each facility that you are registering. *If you have additional facilities that you have either commissioned or purchased over the past year and that you wish to register, please feel free to add them to the list.*

1. Confirmation of which facilities were Lost Time Accident free in 2009 and qualified to register for 2009 ([email spreadsheet if submitting more than one](#)).
2. The accident free man-hours associated with each facility for Jan 1st – Dec 31st, 2009.
3. A completed registration form (attached).
4. A registration fee of **\$75.00** (plus GST) *per facility* payable to GPAC to cover program costs (see attached registration form or [click here to pay online](#))
5. An electronic copy of your company's logo and facility picture emailed to info@gpacanada.com

The logo and facility picture will be displayed during the presentation ceremony. This can either be a picture of the specific facility, the operating team or a combination of something else that represents your company.

If there are facilities that have been transferred or sold, we would appreciate a response indicating who the new operator is, including email address, so that we may contact them for registration.

We request that you provide the required information with completed registration form(s) and fees by **MARCH 31, 2010 to GPAC Safety Awards & Banquet** to the address, email or fax above.
