The GPAC Safety Awards Program is an important part of an industry wide recognition for safe work at gas handling facilities across Canada. Some plants/facilities have been participating in the program since its inception over 30 years ago.

Safety information for the period January 1, 2009 to December 31, 2009 must be submitted before **March 31, 2010** to be considered for the awards. All information received is held **strictly confidential**.

The categories for the awards are:

Category A: GPAC Consultants/Contractors

Predominantly greater than 50% office hours worked (to include consultants, engineering contractor, etc.)

Category B: GPAC Service/Supply

Predominantly greater than 50% warehouse/service/supply hours worked (to include pre-manufactured goods suppliers, chemical suppliers, etc)

Category C: GPAC Shop Fabrication

Predominantly shop fabrication greater than 50% hours worked (to include fab shop, compressor and pump packagers, etc.)

Category D: GPAC Field Construction

Predominantly field construction greater than 50% hours worked (to include all mechanical and electrical contractors).
