NAL RESOURCES SYLVAN LAKE GAS
PLANT
ON THURSDAY, MAY 27, 2010**

Followed by a Golf Game at Alberta Springs Golf Course

NAL Sylvan Lake started up in 1965 and was originally constructed as a “simple” amine plant. It is considered a sweet facility designed to process 52 million cubic feet of gas each day. Additions to the facility include: LPG plant, inlet compression due to reservoir pressure depletion, 3 solution gas conservation compressors and a high pressure gathering system. A reduction of greenhouse gases was accomplished by an acid gas incineration project in 2003.

*****Note: Please bring your own personnel protection: Required - coveralls, eyewear and hardhat. Bring steel toed boots if you have them but they are not required for the tour.**
