- Alberta Energy Regulator: Alberta's single regulator of energy development



AER Mandate

The Alberta Energy Regulator ensures the safe, efficient, orderly, and environmentally responsible development of hydrocarbon resources over their entire life cycle. This includes allocating and conserving water resources, managing public lands, and protecting the environment while providing economic benefits for all Albertans.

Enforcing the Rules

- All AER rules and requirements must be followed
- A new approach to compliance
- More enforcement options and tools when companies fail to comply
- Companies are penalized for noncompliance



Enforcement Approach

- More inspections
- Require detailed plans of action
- Shut down operations
- Administrative penalties
- Prosecution
- Inform Albertans of industry's record
